

STEPS TO DESIGNING A WORD BOOK

- With pencil make each letter: W-O-R-D. Each letter should touch all sides of its square space and will touch its adjacent letter.
- Erase any of the grid pencil lines that remain.
- Color the interior of all the letters using the red colored pencil.
- Using both the green and blue colored pencils, color in all the sections that remain.
- Using the black PITT marker outline the letters and outside border. Do the outside border twice to make it a little thicker.
- Using the white paint marker, decorate each letter with a different element/pattern. Ideas: flowers, cross, star, heart, dots, stripes, waves, diamond....
- Using the metallic marker on the blue colored sections and the black colored PENCIL on the green sections, create “texture” by writing one of the following words over and over to fill the space. TRUTH, FAITH, PEACE, COURAGE, HOPE. Maybe use cursive!
- Using the metallic silver marker, make dots all the way around and on top of the border to resemble lights on a marquee.
